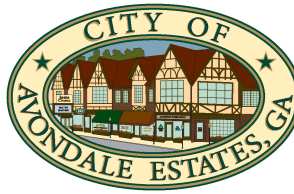

**A RESOLUTION
TO SET COMMERCIAL SANITATION FEES**

WHEREAS, City Charter Section 6.15 authorizes the City to assess and collect a fee for sanitation services; and

WHEREAS, City Code Section 9-82(c) provides that the sanitation fee rate shall be set by resolution; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Mayor and Commissioners wishes to establish a lower fee and level of service for businesses that generate minimal waste;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY the City of Avondale Estates, as follows:

For the year 2022 and each succeeding year until changed by subsequent resolution, the City commercial sanitation fee rates shall be as follows:

Commercial Garbage collection every business day except Wednesdays:	
First 95-gallon receptacle per licensed business unit:	\$695
Each additional receptacle per location:	\$295
Commercial Garbage collection on Wednesdays only:	
One 95-gallon receptacle per licensed business unit:	\$295

Proclamation

WHEREAS, in 1872, J. Sterling Morton proposed to the Nebraska Board of Agriculture that a special day be set aside for planting of trees; and

WHEREAS, this day, now known as ARBOR DAY, was first observed with the planting of more than a million trees in the State of Nebraska; and

WHEREAS, Arbor Day is now observed throughout the United States and the world; and

WHEREAS, trees reduce erosion of our topsoil, reduce heating and cooling costs, moderate temperature, clean air, produce oxygen, and provide habitat for wildlife; and

WHEREAS, trees are a renewable resource that provides paper, wood, fuel, and beauty

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Jonathan Elmore, Mayor of the City of Avondale Estates, Georgia, do hereby proclaim February 18, 2022, as the 149th anniversary celebration of Arbor Day, and urge all citizens to celebrate Arbor Day and support efforts to protect our trees and woodlands.
