


Date: 1932

Name: Abelia Hedge

The hedge was planted in 1932-33 along Avondale Road adjacent to the streetcar line as a project of the Avondale Estates Garden Club. The hedge planting was aided by WPA workers.



Date: 1976

Name: Clock Tower

In 1935-36, the Avondale Estates Garden Club's beatification projects included the construction of a streetcar shelter at the end of the abelia hedge. One account states that in 1976, as part of the country's bicentennial, the clock tower was set atop the streetcar shelter. However, the lower portion of the structure today does not match historic photos of the shelter. It would appear that the current stricter was built anew in 1976.
